Thursday

1PM Group Ride from the Bar Harbor Motel – 21.8 miles, all but 3 miles are Carriage Trails.

6:30PM – We can order pizza at the hotel, splitting the cost of the pizza.

8PM – 10PM – Hospitality in the Bar Harbor Motel breakfast area. (While supplies last!)

Friday

9:30AM Group Ride from the Bar Harbor Motel – 32.7 miles, all Carriage Trails.

Lunch at either the Jordan Pond House Restaurant (18.5 miles) or atop the Day Mountain Loop Trail (22.5 miles). If you are eating at the Jordan Pond House, you might want to have a reservation. Call 207-276-3316.

3:30PM Ice Cream Social – Mount Desert Island Ice Cream, 7 Firefly Lane, right on the Bar Harbor Village Green.

Dinner on your own.

8PM – 10PM – Hospitality in the Bar Harbor Motel breakfast area. (While supplies last!)

Saturday

9:30AM Group Ride from the Bar Harbor Motel – 35.2 miles (20 of which are road, including a 1000 foot climb up Cadillac Mountain over 3.5 miles).

Lunch at Sand Beach around mile 21. (Remember, that this is a packed picnic lunch.)

5:00PM – come have a pre-dinner drink at the Bar Harbor Motel before we set off for dinner.

5:45PM walk to dinner. 6:00PM Dinner at the Stone House at the Bar Harbor Regency Hotel. You will have coupons with your registration materials for Lobster, Grilled Steak or Mushroom Ravioli. Note that there will be a cash bar for anything other than iced tea and coffee/tea with dessert. From 6:00PM to 6:30PM, there will be drinks (cash bar) on the Stone House patio, then we go inside to dinner from 6:30PM to 9:00PM.

Note: I would like to take a group picture with the bikes on either Friday or Saturday (TBD) and also at the patio right before we go in to dinner. More info to follow.
